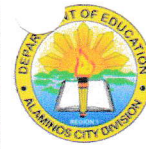

**PARTICULARS**

Bainto**, a coach in swimming and a Senior High School teacher of Pangapisan Integrated School is now at the early stage of pregnancy and it is critical for her to participate in RIAA meet as per advise of her medical doctor. She will be replaced by **Ms. Glory Ann D. Alibuyog** a trained teacher in swimming and a kinder teacher of Palamis Elementary School.

Ms. Bainto is still the in-charge on the preparation of athletes documents and during In-house training. After class hour Ms. Alibuyog will join the swimming team and help Ms. Bainto in giving technical assistance to our athletes. In the RIAA proper Ms. Alibuyog will take charge of the swimming team secondary girls and act as a coach during the competition proper.
