

EXTENSION OF NOMINATION OF SCHOLARS FOR THE KOREA-PHILIPPINES TEACHER EXCHANGE PROGRAMME (KPTEP) 2020

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The International Cooperation Office (ICO) of the Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office announces the extension of nomination of teacherapplicants for the Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Programme (KPTEP) 2020.
- The KPTEP is open to all regular, special education (SPED), and Alternative Learning Systems (ALS)-Mobile educators who have the following qualifications:
 - a. Should have at least five years teaching experience and with at least very satisfactory performance rating;
 - b. Preferably a Master Teacher:
 - c. Have not previously received any funding for longer-than-a-month program from Korean government;
 - d. English language proficient and preferably have basic knowledge in Korean language:
 - e. Should not be more than 50 years old and physically and mentally fit; and
 - f. Must possess a valid passport.
- Requirements (in PDF file) must be submitted to the Human Resource Development Division through hrrd.region1@deped.gov.ph on/before Friday, February 14, 2020, 12 noon. See Annex A for more details.
- 4. Only the regional shortlisted nominees, which will be announced in a separate memorandum, shall be required to submit physical copies of their pertinent documents.
