

DIVISION MEMORANDUM

- 4. The function of the Task Force as provided under item no. 4 of Div Memo No. 078, s. 2020 is amended as follows:
 - a. Cooperate with the Department of Health (DOH) and the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases in Alaminos City on overall city government efforts on addressing the nCoV ARD; Coordinate with the DOH for the implementation of its guidelines in response to the situation, including any decision for school/office lockdown or suspension of classes/work in specific localities should a need arise:
 - b. Monitor the situation in the Division office and schools and ensure the implementation of the DOH guidelines, DepEd standard protocols, and policy directives on nCoV ARD:
 - Promulgate standard protocols in response to the nCoV ARD in Division office and schools, as well as in activities organized, or participated in, by the Department, which may include travel restrictions if necessary;
 - d. Set up a communication protocol and identify an official portal/platform for prompt dissemination of, and quick access to, relevant official information;
 - e. Adopt information dissemination strategies on nCoV ARD and its prevention, control, and management to promote positive health behaviors, and address public fear and anxiety;
 - f. Network and coordinate with other offices within the Division, with relevant government agencies and organizations, and with local government units on resource generation, mobilization for public awareness campaigns, technical assistance, referral and treatment, and other needed support;
 - g. Provide regular status updates and situation reports in the monitoring of the nCoV ARD in offices and schools; and,
 - h. Perform such other functions and activities as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Memorandum, or as the Superintendent may direct.
- The Secretariat of the Task Force shall be the staff of the School Health Division/ SGOD.
