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

This has reference to the recently conducted Teacher-Adviser Training Course (TATC) and Student Leader Development Program (SLDP) last 15 February 2022 to 15 April 2022 via DepEd Learning Management System (DLMS).

Upon review of the said training program, it is revealed in the results that the level of completion of the enrolled teacher-advisers and student leaders were only 33% and 26% respectively.

Steps for Interested Participants without DepEd Email Accounts

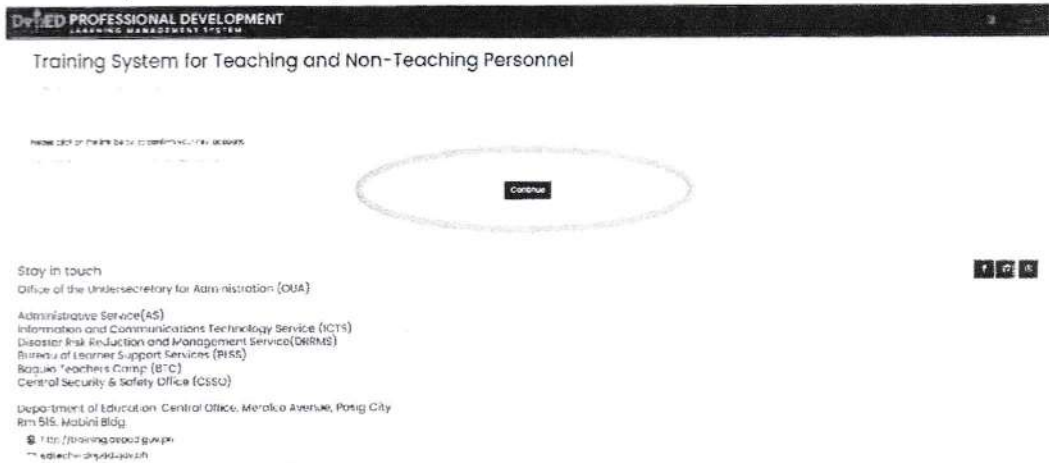
1. Go to <https://training.deped.gov.ph> and type your log in credentials.
2. Click **Log in** and select **New Account**.



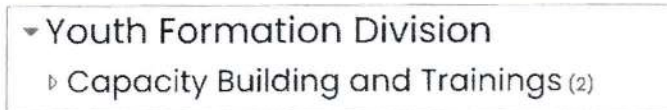
3. Enter your **personal details** then click **Create my new account** tab.

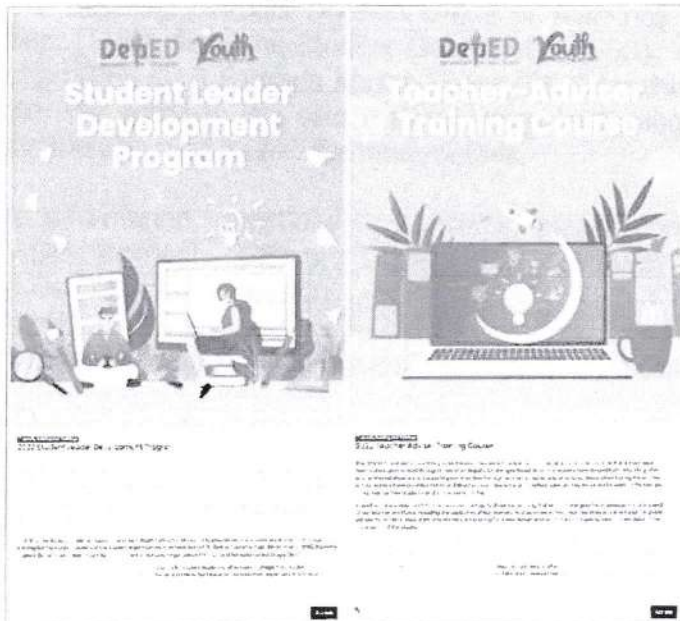
4. Confirm your account by clicking the **Continue** tab.
