- 2. The conduct of Advanced Training Course for Troop Leaders and Outfit Advisors will be in two parts/phases in order to minimize expenses. Part I will be virtual (via Zoom videoconferencing). During this period of training. Participants shall ensure that they have enough data throughout the duration of this phase of the course at it is expected that all shall have open camera at all times.
- 3. Part two shall be limited face to face. Participants are expected to be at the training venue not later than 1500hrs, of the day the Face to Face schedule.
- 4. Participants must have apps for zoom and Padlets and shall use laptop or desktop computer to be able to actively participate with his/her own patrol and crew. We will closely monitor participant's presence in the zoom who are expected to comply with the guidelines o virtual participation.
- 5. We will accommodate forty (40) participants per course. It will be a first come, first serve basis. Local Councils shall collect two thousand five hundred (Php 2,500.00) as reservation fees from the participants coming from their councils.
- 6. Aside from the official uniforms, participants shall bring their own beddings, tent, sleeping gears, working clothes, medicines, poncho, toiletries, flashlight, Filipiña Costume, medical certificate indicating that the participant can do strenuous activities and have complete vaccination including the booster and other personal things. We encourage participants to have at least 2 sets of uniforms.
- 7. For purposes of monitoring the possible conduct of the training courses, Council Scout Executives/Officers-In-Charge are hereby requested to submit to the regional office the application forms of their participants. National Office requires names and BTC Recognition numbers of participants attending the courses.

- 8. Council Scout Executives are hereby advised to extend support to their participants through the provision of the DBM-DILG-DepED Joint Memorandum No. 2 series 2020 which allows payment for Training for DepEd Teaching and non-teaching personnel to their respective Local Governments.
- 9. Other details related to the conduct of these training courses shall be issued from time to time.
- 10. Your kind attention, compliance and widest dissemination to this memorandum is hereby requested.

Greetings!

We are happy to inform you that the Provincial Government of Pangasinan approved our request for sponsorship for the participation of our Boy Scouts District KAB Scout Coordinators, BSP Coordinators and Secondary School Coordinators. A total of 58 slots were given to the Pangasinan-San Carlos City Council having limited number of trained leaders in the Advanced Training Course (Woodbadge). Our letter request allows partials sponsorship amounting to three thousand pesos per participant. Of the fifty eight slots, we are giving your Division 6 slots, 2 for Kawan Leaders, 2 Troop Leaders and 4 for Outfit Advisors.

We also request for issuance of Advisory on the conduct of these trainings for those who will not be accommodated of the sponsorship.

Please allow Mr. Vivencio Vinluan to coordinate with the SDO Alaminos City Division BSP focal person to maximize the number allocated for Pangasinan-San Carlos City Council.
