The Philippine Folk Dance Society (PFDS) in partnership with the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) and the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and the Philippine Folk Dance Society Region 1 Chapter will conduct the 2022 Regional Folk Dance Seminar-Workshop on October 7-9, 2022, at the Provincial

The workshop aims to:

- 1. Develop among teachers the competencies and the necessary knowledge and skill, understanding, and appreciation for folk and traditional dances.
- 2. Provide participants with resource materials on dance that they can use in teaching their students.
- 3. Establish a stronger partnership with DepEd and LGU.

Training Center II, Provincial Capitol Complex, Lingayen, Pangasinan.

- 4. Provide contest pieces for provincial-wide folk dance competition during the "Agew na Pangasinan".
- 5. Provide participants with a forum to discuss and help address their problems and concerns related to the teaching and management of folk dance activities.
- Develop awareness, concern, and love of our own folk, ethnic, and traditional dances.

This three-day seminar-workshop includes dance sessions, lecture demonstrations, a forum, street dance, and culminating showcase by all the participants. Participants will be charged a Php2,500 registration fee to cover expenses for the production of the workshop kit (folk dance instruction, CDs, T-shirt, and certificate) as well as honoraria for the national resource persons and the rondalla staff. Under usual accounting procedures, the registration fee can be charged to the local school fund.

The target participants in this seminar-workshop are teachers from all levels of public and private schools, dance trainers, teacher-in-charge of dance groups, dance directors, choreographers, teachers and students who are members of dance groups, cultural officers, and cultural event coordinators.

Attached is an approved letter of the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) requesting permission from the DepEd Secretary, Madam Leonor M. Briones, to conduct a series of workshops under the 2022 Arts Academy, including National Folk Dance Workshops by the Philippine Folk Dance Society (PFDS).
