

The Stefanie Quintin Voice Masterclass is a FREE special training program that is dedicated to training six (6) students who are taking a special program in the arts, specifically for those specializing in Music or Vocal Performance. The participants will take part in lectures, discussions, and exercises on vocal performance. The program also welcomes observers who are SPA and MAPEH Teachers nationwide.

Soprano Stefanie Quintin is the first featured soloist of this year's CCP Special Concert Series. Her concert will be held on September 7, 2022, 7:30 PM at the Tanghalang Ignacio Gimenez.

Stefanie Quintin embraces multivocality in her work as a performer. The Straits Times called her a vocalist who "possesses a voice with remarkable flexibility and a truly commanding musical presence." Stefanie received a Bachelor of Music in Vocal Pedagogy and Performance (cum laude) from the University of the Philippines and a Master of Arts in Contemporary Music Performance from the University of California, San Diego. She received the Delphic Lyra Award for Traditional Music at the Third International Junior Delphic Games in 2007, the PGMA Presidential Award for Culture and the Arts (2008), and the Rey Paguio Scholarship (2009-2014). In 2018, she won first place in the opera-professional category of the second SLO-ASEAN Vocal Competition. She is a part of the Manila-based Pierrot ensemble "Ripieno Ensemble PH", which is committed to promoting and performing contemporary music in the Philippines and Southeast Asia.
