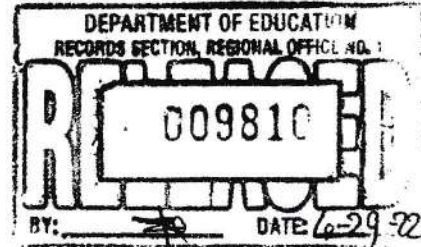

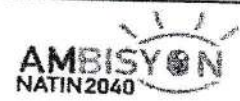

**SUBJECT: DISSEMINATION OF ARTS ONLINE LEARNING RESOURCE

Sections 14, 15, and 17 under Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares that the state shall foster the preservation, enrichment, and dynamic evolution of a Filipino culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression. The constitution likewise mandates the state to conserve, develop, promote, and popularize the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resource as well as artistic creations. It further provides that all the country's artistic and historic wealth constitutes the nation's cultural treasure and shall be under the protection of the state, which may regulate its disposition.

The Department of Education and the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) worked hand in hand to uphold the said mandate. Hence, CCP through its ARTS ONLINE program has curated a collection of learning resources. ARTS ONLINE is a video streaming platform for the "new normal" that continues to engage and connect artists to their audiences through art workshops, artists' talk, and lecture-demo of the different art forms. These are learning opportunities for children, for general audience, for artists and for learners and parents - making art matter to every Filipino.

In light of covid-19, ensuring that Filipinos will still benefit from educational assets of the arts, ARTS ONLINE aims to: (1) provide platform for the community of art learners and artist/teachers; (2) engage and broaden audiences for arts appreciation and learning; (3) create opportunities for artists to continue their work in arts education; and (4) provide learning materials for the arts curriculum.
