# Digital Storytelling Workshop Specification

As an alternative to the typical teaching/training lectures, this hybrid short course on digital storytelling covers the fundamentals of technologically backed storytelling. The focus of the training is on how to communicate, educate, and train others through the inspirational power of tales.

To accomplish their duties, participants will need to engage in both in-person and online sessions, as well as in an optional culminating activity where their finished digital story will be displayed.

## Objectives:

Participants should be able to:

- write a digital story's script
- skillfully use picture and sound manipulation to convey narrative themes and emotions
- create a brief digital tale.

Requirements for course output:

To succeed in this course, Participants need to be capable of:

- The script for a digital narrative
- produced and scored an audio bed for a digital story.
- a finished digital story that is published on a gallery website
- Brief description of the project employing a digital tale as a teaching or training tool or giving students one

The topics covered will be a 3 hour (or half day) synchronous or face to face class activity to showcase and critique final outputs of the participants.

- Basics of Storytelling From "once upon a time until the end"
- Creating your Visuals Basic design principles whenever we create something visual
- Setting Audio From dialogue to effects. Basics of recording and simple technology to use
- Writing the Digital Story it is the process of writing the digital story. The style we'll follow will be a sort of
  checklist, if you will, to facilitate the development of an idea, or plot line, into a narrative that will be
  interesting and engaging to the viewer
