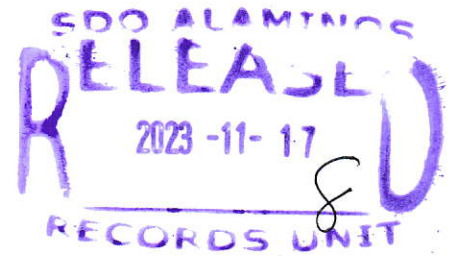

1. This Office shall conduct the Local Stakeholders Convergence on November 23, 2023, 8:00 AM, at Don Leopoldo Convention Center
2. The activity aims to present the accomplishments of all public elementary and secondary schools in terms of their stakeholders' support and to recognize their partners' topmost involvement and participation in the delivery of services to our schools.
3. Each cluster shall present a maximum of a five (5) minute video presentation that features their accomplishments in line with strong partnerships and linkages of local stakeholders that supported PPAs related to schools' maintenance and improvement of facilities, implementation of reading and numeracy programs, and learners' empowerment through leadership and promotion of Children's rights. 4. This activity shall include the celebration of the following:
 - a. Reading Month;
 - b. Children's Month; and
 - c. Student Leaders' Month
5. The participants in this convergence are the School Heads, SPTA Presidents, 1 student leader in each school, 1 participant and 1 coach for the book parade (elementary), 1 teacher-coach for oral reading interpretation (secondary), and identified SNEd and ALS learners and teachers.

Mechanics and Criteria for the Book Character Costume Parade

1. The contest is open to Grade 3 to 6 learners.
2. There will only be one (1) contestant from each public elementary school.
3. Contestants will choose a book character, local or foreign, that they are going to portray.
4. They will also bring a copy of the book that contains the character they are representing. If the book is not available, a book cover that has the title and author of the book may be made/created.
5. The criteria for judging are:
 - Originality.....25%
 - Creativity (costume appeal and use of props).....30%
 - Characterization (character portrayal, stage presence).....35%
 - Audience Impact.....10%
 - Total.....100%**
6. The top three (3) winners will receive certificates of recognition and a token.

Mechanics and Criteria for the Oral Reading Interpretation

1. The contest is open to Grade 7 to 10 learners at the same time a student leader.
2. There will only be one (1) contestant from each public secondary school.
3. Contestants will choose a story from Philippine or English literature which they are going to read orally, in not more than 10 minutes, before an audience. They should be able to demonstrate their interpretative skills and ability to communicate using effective verbal and non-verbal cues in reading a story aloud.
4. The criteria for judging are:
 - Oral interpretation.....50%
 - ✓ Read aloud accurately the message/theme, emotions, mood, character, and all other elements of the story
 - ✓ Establish creative and dramatic impact throughout the presentation
 - Voice projection.....30%
 - ✓ Speak clearly, distinctly, and with appropriate and varied pauses, pitch, and tone modulation
 - ✓ Recite loudly enough for the audience to hear
 - Stage presence.....20%
 - ✓ Show confidence and appropriate posture/projection, facial expressions, and gestures
 - Total.....100%**
5. The top three (3) winners will receive certificates of recognition and a token.

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Mechanics and Criteria for the Reading Corner

1. The contest is open to all clusters including ALS and SNEd.
2. There will only be one (1) contestant from each cluster.
3. The reading corner shall have an area of 3m x 5m.
4. There shall be one (1) student leader to stay in the reading corner.
5. The reading corner can be of any design as long as it creates an inviting and stimulating reading corner that promotes the enjoyment of reading.
6. The criteria for judging are:

Physical Set-Up & Artistry.....	35%
Appropriateness of Reading Materials.....	35%
Creativity and Resourcefulness.....	20%
Over-all Impact.....	10%
Total.....	100%
7. The top three (3) winners will receive certificates of recognition and a token.

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
