CRITERIA & MECHANICS OF THE DIFFERENT CONTEST:

Mechanics:

- Must be a registered girl scout and troop leader of the current year.
- Field Advisers must pre-register their participants to the Event Coordinators of their congressional district prior to the contest.
- There will be only 1 entry per district for elementary level. For secondary level, entry for senior level is separate for cadet level.
- 4. We will choose top three (3) for every contest per level per congressional district.
- 5. All top 3 winners will be the one to compete during the Provincial Level Competition.
- Please observe the correct and proper wearing of uniform.
- Field Advisers are advice to orient their contestants and coach regarding the mechanics to avoid disqualification.
- The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.
- P 25.00 from the Registration will be given to host District/School for venue, food of guests & committees and other expenses.
- Registration Fee could be charge to SEF or MOOE.
- Troop Leaders will be granted 1 day service credit in reference to DECS Memorandum No. 143, s. 1997.

- 1. Minimum of 20 participants.
- 2. Attire: Council Anniversary Shirt and GSP Jogging Pants
- 3. There will be one (1) music per District:

4th District - Forever Young

5th District - Rivers of Babylon

6th District -Get Louder

- Participants should place in a cartolina/tarpaulin the ingredients, procedure and costing of their entry.
- Main ingredients should be fresh fruits. No cooking in the venue.

FLASH MOB (Senior & Cadet Level)

- 3. Time limit will be minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 5 minutes including entrance & exit.
- 4. Use of Pyrotechnic gadgets, smokes or combustible material as props are not allowed.

1.	Choreography	- 30%

3.	Originality	- 25 %
4	Over -all Impact	- 20%

8 POINT CHALLENGE QUIZ BEE (Junior Level)

Mechanics:

- A group of three (3) Junior Girl Scouts will compose the District's team.
- All teams will answer the same set of questions in writing. Before a question is read, the contestants must raise their pen.
- A team may discuss with each other but only one (1) answer per team is accepted. The team will designate a scribbler. What the scribbler writes on the paper shall be the official answer of the team.
- Questions will read twice by the Quizmaster. After the second reading, the Quizmaster shall say "go" ---- only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the ten (10) second time limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
- After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the teams will automatically stop writing and raise their pen.
- 6. The teams will be asked to read aloud their answer with the proctor verifying it.
- Answers with wrong spelling are wrong.
- There are four (4) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult, and Clincher.
 Note: The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
- In the Easy Round, two (2) questions will be asked; Average Round, three (3) questions; in the Difficult Round, Five (5) questions; and in the Clincher Round, as many questions as needed.
- The Quiz Bee will utilize the point system in all of the competitions.
- 11. Points are assigned for each question:

Easy question 1 point
Average question 2 points
Difficult question 3 points
Clincher question 5 points

- After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each team is tabulated.
- The team who gets the highest number of points is automatically declared the Champion; and the rest will be Runner – up. (1st, 2std and 3std Runner- Up).
- 14. Should there be a tie among the teams getting the highest score or the second (2nd) highest score, the contest continues to the Clincher Round to determine the Champion or the Runnerup as the case may be.
- The total number of points of the tied teams will revert back to zero (0)
- In the Clincher Round, as many questions will be asked. Each question is assigned five (5) points. The team who first (1st) gets fifteen (15) points is declared the Winner.
- Should another tie occur after the third (3rd) Clincher question, one (1) more question will be asked to break the tie and so on until a winner is declared.
- 18. The duly registered coach of the team is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
- The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all question/protests.
- No bags or other materials are allowed near the team once the quiz bee start. Writing materials
 will be provided by the Council at the start of the contest.

e) DISTRICT COMMITTEES	-At least 60% FEMALE & 40% MALE (Parents/Community Women/Volunteer Workers/School Commissioners)
f) ASSOCIATE MEMBERS	-Parents/Volunteer Workers/Community Women/Male/All friends of GSP

g) CAREER WOMAN	- Volunteer Career Women
h) TREFOIL GUILD MEMBERS	-Former Girl Scouts who are 21 Years Old Above
i) HONORARY MEMBERS	-LGU /Municipal Officials

BENEFITS:

Members of the GSP can avail of the following financial assistance from the mutual assistance fund:

a) Death caused by Accident	P 7,000.00
o) Natural Death Burial Assistance	2,500.00
c) Medical / Hospitalization Reimbursement	4,000.00
d) Rape	2,500.00

RESTRICTIONS OF THE BENEFITS:

- Self-inflicted incidents such as suicide and drug/substance abuse are not entitled to any financial assistance.
- Illnesses due to immoral conduct and natural causes such as: child delivery, physical check-up, cosmetic or other related surgeries, alcoholism, use of prohibited drugs, selfinflicted injury, and the like is not entitled to any financial assistance.
- The maximum medical assistance is up to P4,000.00 only.
- For victims of rape, members can avail of the P2,500.00 financial assistance only when proven true by circumstantial evidence.

APPLICATION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Submit to the Council the accomplished Financial Assistance Request Form (FARF) with all the required documents.

For Death (Accidental/natural cause)

- Death Certificate (with Registry Number and Official Seal of Local Registrar's Office).
- Supplementary Medical Report or Hospital Record (if the girl/adult died in a hospital).
- 3. Police Report or barangay Report (as appropriate).

For Rape:

- NBI/police Medico Legal Report Barangay Report
- 2. Medical/Hospital Certificate

For Medical/Hospital Reimbursement:

- Original copy of medical bills and official receipts and medical certificate.
- Physician's prescriptions of medicines purchased.
- Police Report/Blotter (for vehicular accident) or narrative report.
- 4. Original laboratory and X-ray findings.

Required Period of Submission:

- a. The FARF, with or without all the required documents, must be submitted to the GSP National Headquarters within <u>sixty days (60 days)</u> from the date of accident/death. The basis of the date of submission of the FARP to the NHQ is the post mark date (the date the Council mailed the documents to NHQ).
- Completion of all the required documents must be sub mitted to the GSP NHQ within one hundred eighty (180) days after the incident.

Financial Assistance shall be denied for non compliance of A & B and for the following conditions:

- Tampered, padded, or spurious medical receipts.
- Confinement due to natural sickness.

Registration starts AUGUST to DECEMBER. It is advisable for any In-Charge registering the troop to remit registration fees upon collection or else she is held responsible when accident happen.

AGE LIMIT

Notwithstanding the Age Limit under this policy. It is hereby declared and agreed that the coverage is extended to registered members of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines who are more than Sixty Five (65) years of age but not to exceed Eighty (80) years.

Additional Ten Pesos (P10.00) is to be collected from Pupils/Students for the Sustaining Membership Extension upon registration starting August of School Year and Shared as follows:

Council Share	50%
Troop Share (Only for Girl Scouting Activities)	20%
Field Adviser's Share (For travel expenses and	
Coordinating Meeting)	10%
Commissioner's Share (For travel & training expenses)	10%
Division Share (For meetings & travel expenses)	10%

In the event that a school could not register a Troop, the percentage due to the school shall be forfeited in favor of the Council & Division.
